- 4. In 1, replace VHF with "radio"
- 5. Take out #4
- 6. Change "its" volunteers to "radio volunteers"
- 7. Discussions that the Red Cross owns the HF rig, but that John Reynolds of Jax, provided the dual band rig and the antennas and masts. (General agreement tohave John give us a show and tell demo.)
- 8. outfitting of "amateur radio" volunteers

Side discussion: Batteries seemed to be even more important.

9. Change VHF/UHF and HF antennas to "antennas" and "at" another location

Side discussion: Note that Alachua County is the storage for the Marc III trailer with a repeater and the cache of fireman's radios.
